Brace Yourself! Polish Parliament Election coming this autumn!

Polish Parliament Election approaching

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USPA NEWS - This autumn, Parliament Election in Poland will be unusual then in previous years. Two women will take competition for the Prime Minister chair to rule Polish government for next four years - actual Prime Minister Ewa Kopacz and the Beata Szydło.

The Parliament campaign started this week by Party Conventions of actual ruling Civil Platform and the opposite Law and Justice Party. At these conventions were presented two candidates for a Prime Minister position. Civil Platform Campaign as expected will be led by current Prime Minister Ewa Kopacz, former minister of health in Donald Tusk (current President of European Union) cabinet and former marshal of Polish Parliament. She became Prime Minister after Donald Tusk's dismissal in September 2011. Tusk resigned from his office because he was chosen for a new President of European Union (pledge in November 2014). After a year of her rule, she became very unpopular keeping the social attitudes the lowest for a year.

His rival will be viceleader of Law and Justice Party Beata Szydło, former leader of president-elect Andrzej Duda's presidential campaign in which she took a big part. On his party convention she was selected by current leader of Law and Justice, Jarosław Kaczyński - brother of tragic dead in Smolensk accident President Lech Kaczyński. Mrs. Szydło said she will be open for dialogue with everybody. But if she wins election will she be enough independent from her party or she will be just a doll of Jarosław Kaczyński, who is very unpopular around Polish people? Answer for this question we will get this autumn. After presidential election which result was 51.55% for right wing Duda and 48.45 for Bronisław Komorowski, actual president, Polish society is split as never before.

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
